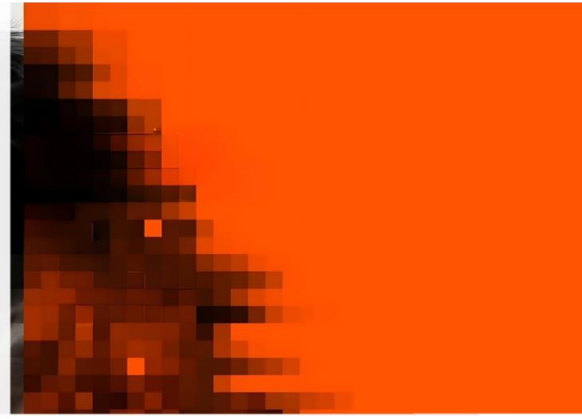

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **Payments:**
Email to georgeridingclub@gmail.com by entry closing date, failing which the entry will not be processed.
2. **Horse flu and AHS vaccinations:**
 - No horse may enter the show without up-to-date horse flu and AHS vaccinations,
 - Complete date & batch number on entry form.
3. **Horses with infectious diseases.**
 - The competitor undertakes not to bring any horse or person to the show that has an infectious disease, whether notifiable or not.
4. **Cancellations and scratching after closing date of entries:**
 - NO refunds will be made in respect of cancellations and scratching after closing date of entries.
5. **Discretion to cancel classes:**
 - The Organizing Committee reserves the rights to combine, vary, divide, or cancel classes if insufficient entries are received.
6. **Changing of program and conditions:**
 - As far as possible, the program and conditions relating thereto will be adhered to.
 - The Organizing Committee reserves the right to make alterations in the event of:
 - Unfavorable weather conditions or any other unforeseen circumstances
 - Should the show be cancelled for any reason only 80% of entry fees will be refunded.



7. Indemnity:

None of the following organizers or officials by these organizers can be held responsible in any way for damage, loss, injury sustained by owners, competitors, or members of the public or another other people for the duration of a show at the George riding Show:

- SAEF, the DSA, SASJ, SASA & SAEQA & the GRC,

8. Rules for Stallions:

- By entering a stallion, the competitor & owner agree to the following conditions & agree to abide by the following protocol:
 - Competition stallions remain the responsibility of the owner & rider at all times & they are expected to have public liability against any loss, injury or damage that might be caused by the stallion.
 - It is the responsibility of the owner & rider to ensure that the stallion cannot exit the stable allocated to it on its own/or with the help of another horse or uninformed person.
 - The stallion may only be removed from the stable during the show for exercise & preparation/competition & only in the presence of a responsible handler or rider.
 - Under NO circumstances shall the covering of mares be allowed to take place at the GRC premises.
 - Stallions to always wear a yellow tag.
 - Passports that include a valid Height Certificate must be available at show.

9. Registration with SAEF

- All competitors must be registered with SAEF.
- Organizers reserve the right to fine, warn, suspend and/or eliminate any rider that does not abide by the SAEF rules.

10. Incomplete entries and entries without proof of payment:

- Incomplete entries/ entries without payment will be excluded.
- Riders will still be liable for entry fees if entries are not deleted before close of entries.

11. Rules regarding excessive use of whips will be enforced.

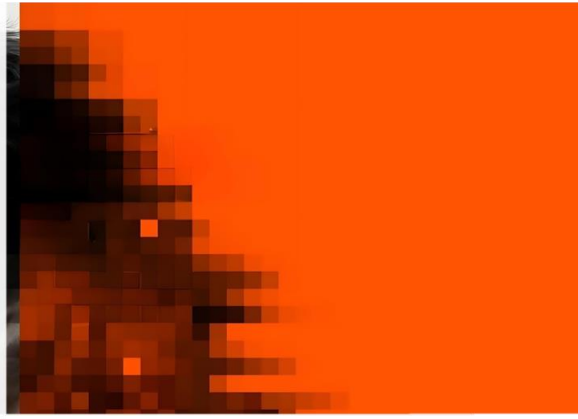
12. Interference with decisions of Judges, Stewards or Officials

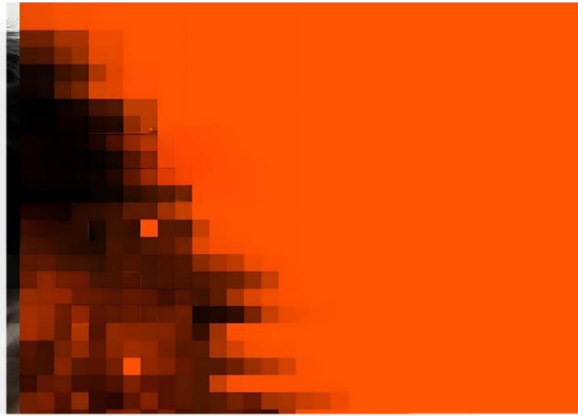

- Non SASA members can pay a Temporary Membership of R100 with their entry fee and will not earn any Grading or Victor Ludorum Points.** Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za
- SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTS competitors in all classes. The competitor must be an EDTS member of SASA. Membership is free. EDTS application forms, rules and conditions are available at www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za EDTS members will earn EDTS Victor ludorum points.
- There may be no cross entries between Newcomer Classes and any Open or Novice Classes. Cross entries between Newcomer and SASA Riding Horse Classes are permitted.
- There may be no cross entries of horses/ponies between Novice and Open Showing Classes. Open Horses/Ponies may compete in Novice Working classes (if eligible).
- No SASA membership required to enter the SASA Riding Horse Classes, unless earning points for National Victor Ludorums.
- SASA Instructors of registered competitors will earn National Instructors Victor Ludorum points.
- Horses and Riders take part in this competition at their own risk.
- The Organisers reserve the right to limit the number of entries accepted to a manageable number, on a first come first served basis.
- Any and all decisions made by the Show Director in terms of the collation, organisation and management of the Show will be deemed final, and no further correspondence will be entered into.

AFRICAN HORSE SICKNESS: Horses from outside the AHS Surveillance area must have valid AHS vaccinations (12 months) and a current Certificate of Movement. All horses must arrive at the showgrounds accompanied by a valid Horse Passport. Current Equine flu vaccinations (6 months) - compulsory.
